Enacted in 1933, the Buy American Act specifies that the U.S. government, and certain other third parties that receive federal funds for qualifying projects, must give preferred status to goods that are manufactured in the United States when making purchases.

In order to maintain the best pricing for our customers, Hunter products (primarily controllers, pop-ups, and sensors) that are not listed above are either manufactured outside of the United States or include parts manufactured outside of the United States.

The requirements set forth by the Buy American Act can be waived if a domestically manufactured product is at least 25% more expensive than a comparable foreign-sourced product, if a product is not available domestically in sufficient quantity, or if using a domestically sourced product is not in the public's best interest.

The Buy American Act should not be confused with the Buy America Act. Enacted in 1983, the Buy America Act applies only to federally funded mass-transit projects.
