Save Water



Check the System

Work with your landscape maintenance contractor to assess the performance of your irrigation system. Check for leaks, clogs, and wear that could be silently wasting countless gallons of water. At a minimum, adjust sprinkler nozzles to eliminate overspray onto surrounding hardscapes.



Plant Responsibly

Be selective with turf areas. Keep turf only where practical and use a regionally appropriate variety. Replace thirsty plants with native and drought-tolerant plants. Add mulch to reduce evaporation and moderate soil temperature.
