For the Hunter HC controller, use 802.11B/G

For the Hunter Pro-HC, HPC-FP, Pro-C Hydrawise, and HCC use 802.11 B/G/N

The router must broadcast a 2.4 GHz signal. If you have a dual band router (i.e., 2.4 GHz and 5 GHz), do not disable the 2.4 GHz signal.

Some new routers may require you to set the channel between 1 and 11.

Set the Security Type to WPA or WPA2.

The network must not contain enterprise access points that have been configured to require certificates or other forms of enterprise authentication.

Hydrawise-ready controllers cannot connect to guest networks or networks that use a portal page to log in.
